

BORDER GROUP PARISH COUNCIL WARD COUNCILLOR REPORT SEPT 2021

I have, this month sent the clerk and chair a copy of the Leader of the Council's report which I hope they will circulate and councillors will find interesting. There will be some items which are more so than others and I won't send it if you think it is of no use but it will ensure that everything that is happening from a Herefordshire Council point of view is relayed to you. I will then concentrate my report on issues relating to the parish which should reduce the size of my report and potentially shorten the meeting. I am obviously happy to answer questions on both reports

In the Leader's report you will note that we now have 6.9 years housing land supply and this means that Border Group's NDP will now continue to carry significant weight after it is 2 years old which I am sure is a relief.

The planning application for The Old Post Office has been withdrawn and it likely that the application for yurts at Willey will go to committee on 29th September.

I sent you an email from a resident concerned about the state of the Herefordshire Trail. Some of this has been picked up by Stapleton Group PC and I believe some of it is Border Group's responsibility, however some of the places mentioned I do not know.

I have had a complaint from a resident about issues relating to Lingen Bridge. Lee has advised this is the responsibility of the land owner and I have passed his details to Lee.

With regard to the request for a visibility mirror in Adforton I have raised the issue with Lee who is looking to see whether there is a suitable site.

There has been some anti-social behaviour in Adforton which has involved the police.
